The duties include but are not limited to:

- To be responsible for the entire Vetting within the organization. To ensure that systems, processes and practices are implemented, maintained and developed in accordance with relevant best practice, policy and legislation.
 - o Leading and coordinating the activities of the Vetting Department
 - o Control the validity of Oil Majors inspection
 - o Arrange third party inspections such as Oil Major, CDI and ensure operator comments are sent in due time
 - o Maintain and regularly update vetting related data in dedicated software
- To provide the strategic and tactical direction for vetting activity within the organization, to ensure that current and future needs of the organization are met.
- To plan and manage the day-to-day requirements for the maintenance which include conducting spotchecks on individuals to monitor compliance with vetting policies within the organization.
- To devise, develop, administrate and maintain a rolling programmed of vetting for all staff including contractors, and others, who may wish to gain access into the organization premises.
- To act as the single point of contact (SPOC) for the organization and advice and update on changes in legislation, National Policy and procedure and organization compliance related issues in respect of Vetting.
- Encouraging a positive, can do, attitude, nurturing teamwork and a one-team concept.
- Providing input to the annual budget process for areas falling under his area of responsibility eg. Vetting.
- Monitoring the fleet's performance against the agreed KPI's and driving initiatives to improve performance, particularly those related to vetting inspections.
- Being the primary point of contact with the fleet for post fixture commercial operations and ensuring that the Owners and Managing Director is kept advised of all developments in this area.
- Arranging vetting / terminal inspections when required, coordinating the response to deficiencies raised and ensuring these are entered in the OCIMF SIRE web site in a timely manner.
- Ensuring vetting deficiencies are followed up and closed out with appropriate secondary comments being entered on the SIRE web site.
- Checking that Masters carry out self-vetting inspections and these are followed up and closed out.
- Providing input and participating on the annual Management Review.

 - o Carrying out documented accident / incident investigation incl. identification of root cause, corrective and preventative measures
